Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting

Discolored HVAC exhaust ventilation system:

1. Eight (8) discolored (unpainted) HVAC exhaust ventilation system.

Paint all HVAC exhaust ventilation system (looks dirty due to lack of appropriate paint).

Humidity on Light' Bulb Lamp Cover:

1.Prep area Infront/above of Walk-in-Cooler and Walk-in-Freezer (humidity inside of Light Bulb Lamp' Cover).

Clean and/or remove humidity inside Light Bulb Lamp' Cover.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
