*Physical Education (PE) State Requirement

The 2008 Legislature passed Senate Bill 610 which was signed into law by Governor Crist on June 2, 2008. It included changes in State Statute as it relates to the physical education requirements for students in Florida.

To encourage students to become more physically active and to help students develop healthy lifestyles, Senate Bill 610 requires the equivalent of one class period per day of physical education for a minimum of <u>one semester</u> each year for students in grades 6 through 8.

The physical education requirement shall be waived for a student who meets one of the following criteria:

- The student is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course.
- The student's parent or guardian indicates in writing to the school that the student is enrolled in another course from among those offered as electives by the school District.

This Statute requires each school board to notify parents of the electives available to them prior to scheduling a student in physical education.

<u>Unless your child meets one of the waiver criteria listed above, he/she will be enrolled in physical education for a minimum of one semester of each year while in grades 6 through 8.</u>
