Independent Reading Activities

Incoming third graders are expected to read the following books over summer vacation. All the books listed can be accessed on myON through the student portal. After reading each book, students should complete the myON test.

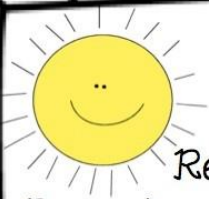
