Tardy/Attendance Policy

- After the 8:35 bell rings, your child is considered "tardy" and he/she needs to pick up a "tardy pass" from the main office then proceed to the classroom.
- In order for a student to be awarded perfect attendance, they must be present everyday.



Uniform Policy

- The school uniform consists of navy, white and burgundy shirts with navy blue bottoms. Jeans and khaki pants/shorts are NOT part of the uniform for elementary students. Plaid skirts are an option for girls.
- Jeans are allowed with the school spirit
 t-shirt on Friday only!
- Sweaters must be navy blue.

Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

- Students are to report to the classroom in the morning.
- Please notify teacher if your child will be leaving early via ClassDojo or a note. Understand that your child will be missing instructional time <u>and</u> is expected to make up any missed assignments.
- If your child will be leaving with another adult, please send a note.
- 2nd grade students are dismissed at the front of the school. Dismissal is at 3:05 Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays. Wednesday, dismissal is at 1:50
- Please use your purple window pass with your child's name for a quicker pickup.



Student Responsibilities

- Students need to be prepared for the day.
- Students need to have ALL their necessary materials with them <u>and</u> completed assignments.
- Write home learning assignments as they are written on the board, project due dates, and assessments in agenda.
- Communicate with teacher and parents.
- Check "Blue -HW" folder and Agenda nightly.



Assessments

- Students are <u>usually</u> tested on the biweekly basis. Due to the instructional focus layout of the pacing guide.
- However, we may test each Friday on specific skill but, I will inform you of each test/ date via ClassDojo.
- There will be times when I will reschedule a test to another date if more time is needed to complete the lessons.
- Spelling Tests will be on Mondays.

Home Learning Policies

- Students need to complete ALL assignments on a daily basis <u>and</u> have the assignment in school.
- If an assignment is not done, the student will receive a "No Home Learning" notice. Students with 3 missing Home Learning Assignments will receive a conference notice.
- Students are responsible for copying the assignments into their agendas on a <u>daily basis</u>.



Online Programs

- Each student <u>MUST</u> learn their student ID number and password.
- As of now, only the IReady online program have begun.
- All students <u>must</u> have their own device.
- All parents and students will be notified of usernames, passwords and weekly expectations.
- Programs that will be used are IReady, MyOn and Reflex Math and are expected to be completed at home.

Parent Conferences

- Parent conferences are available upon request and a note written to the teacher in your child's agenda or simply reach out to me via Class Dojo.
- On the day of the conference, please report <u>directly</u> to the main office. A pass will be given to you to proceed to the classroom. Due to COVID restraints...we may also meet via ZOOM or conduct a telephone



- Students will work on I-Ready Math every week. 45 minutes of instruction are required each week.
- Daily math lessons are exactly as their nightly homework.
- There are also times when I will assign Math lessons through the student portal. Here the students will be able to review and complete a lesson based on the day's activity. The program automatically grades the lesson and I use it as a homework grade.



- Students will work on I-Ready Reading every week. 45 minutes of instruction are required each week.
- Read daily for 30 min. to build fluency, acquire vocabulary and open their minds to the adventures and to the knowledge a book offers.
- Students will have access to books at the Public library and on the student portal via MyOn.
